Open Access Endoscopy

For a successful endoscopy, you must fast for 6 hours before the procedure. You will be seen by the Gastroenterologist prior to the endoscopy on the day of your admission to Flinders Private Hospital.

Please bring a list of medications you are taking, as well as any relevant X-rays.

*If you are diabetic, or on blood thinners (anticoagulants) you will require a preprocedure consultation with the Gastroenterologist. At this appointment you will receive instructions relating to medication you are currently taking and procedure information.

After the procedure, your doctor will speak with you and give you a provisional written result report.

You must not drive for 24 hours following the procedure. A responsible adult should be with you for the first 24 hours after the procedure.

Facilitated Access Colonoscopy

All patients referred for colonoscopy require a pre-procedure consultation with the gastroenterologist. You will be given detailed procedure information and patient instructions at this consultation.
